Casal de Ventozela Pseudonimo Pet Nat, Spain

A dry Vino Verde, planted on 45 hectares and excels in sustainable growing in granite. Presents with notes of pear, peach and apricot

with arborio rice, ham and a chocolate wine reduction

Espresso Cocoa Rubbed Pork Kebab

with a lemon zest chimichurri and whipped potato

Le Berceau Blanquette de Limoux, Languedoc, France

A very dry wine made with the Mauzac grape. This wine is fermented naturally without pesticides and presents with notes of apple, yeast and lime.

“Le Berceau” means “the cradle” of birthplace of sparkling wine. This vineyard was owned by the same family from 1926-2011

Desserts

Chocolate covered strawberries, raspberry white chocolate cheesecake bars, dark chocolate fig tartlets, chocolate brownie cookies (GF, DF) and dark chocolate cherry bark.

Cascina Garintina Niades Brochette D' Acqui. Piedmont, Italy

A light and refreshing dessert wine from vineyards in Alto Monferrato, Piedmont.

Crafted through a very small production of hand harvested grapes featuring cold maceration. This wine is 85% Barbera and the remaining 15% is between Brachetto, Dolcetto, Pinot Nero, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

About \$25-\$36 per bottle

R. Dumont et Fils Brut Rose - Champagne, France

Made exclusively from Pinot Noir this wine is aged for two years on the lees before disgorgement. Presents with notes of berry and cream.

About \$40-\$50 per bottle
